Visit of Grande Dixence Dam and wine tasting tour in Wallis

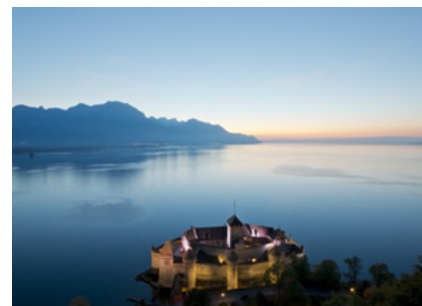
Explore the impressive **Grande Dixence Dam**, the world's highest gravity dam, which gathers water from 35 Valaisian glaciers in the region surrounding Zermatt and Val d'Hérens. This monumental structure, built between 1951 and 1965, boasts incredible dimensions, with a base thickness of 200 meters, a length of 695 meters, and a height of 285 meters. A guided «sound and light» tour takes you inside the dam, followed by a cable car ride to the top, offering panoramic views of the Valais mountains and the expansive lake.

Afterward, enjoy a wine-tasting experience and a delicious lunch amidst the vineyards of Fully. Take in the tranquil ambiance as you savor the flavors of Wallis wines and immerse yourself in the region's winemaking heritage.



Chillon Castle

Visit **Chillon Castle**, an exceptional heritage monument situated on a rocky island. With its strategic location and historical significance, the castle has stood since the Bronze Age. Explore the castle's interiors and admire the diverse collection of furniture, weapons, and armor on display.
